**CAMP WILDERNESS: Reservation Only.** Located near Ponderosa Lodge off of the Western Divide Hwy. Facilities include cabins, lodge, kitchen, showers, and restrooms. Fees: \$10 per person per night, 3-night minimum; \$200 minimum fee per night.

**BALCH PARK: No reservations** (559) 539-3896 on site phone

Located within Mtn Home State Forest at 6,400 feet, all campsites at Balch Park are first-come, first-served. Fees: Day Use \$1.00 per person per day, Camping 80 sites \$16.00 per night (\$8.00 Seniors or Disabled) Facilities include three bathrooms with flush toilets, running water, small museum, two fishing ponds stocked once a week when open.

**CHOLOLLO CAMPGROUND: On the Tule River Indian Reservation** (559) 781-4271

Facilities include running water, porta-potties. Fees: 2 nights for up to 6 people \$18.00, Overnight for up to 6 people \$10.00, Day Use per site \$5.00, Fishing permit per day \$3.00.
