**Accomplishments:** *This project involved the additions of large woody debris to 5.0 miles of Silver Creek that was impacted as a result of the Silver Fire of 2002. The purpose of the project was to restore woody debris that was lost as a result of the Silver Fire, improve stream channel complexity, provide cover for fish, and a point of scour for pool formation. In addition to the woody debris, large boulder clusters were placed throughout the project area.*
