Dear Forest Planning Participant:


Presently the Fremont National Forest has two semi-primitive non-motorized (SPNM) areas on the Silver Lake Ranger District. These are the Buck Creek and Antler SPNM areas located in T. 30 S. and T. 31 S., R. 12 E. The Buck creek SPNM area is adjacent to the Yamsay Mountain Semi-Primitive Recreation area on the Winema National Forest.

After completion of a site-specific Environmental Assessment (EA) Charles E. Stocks, the Silver Lake District Ranger signed a decision to close Forest Service Road 3038024 to motorized use, between Buck Creek and Antler SPNM areas. This closure was needed to meet the objectives of the Fremont National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan (Forest Plan).

Because the Yamsay Mountain Semi-Primitive Recreation area (Winema National Forest) and the Buck Creek and Antler SPNM areas are now contiguous, to simplify identification and management, the combined areas will be called the Yamsay Mountain Semi-Primitive Recreation area.

Thank you for your continued interest in planning on the Fremont National Forest.
