

**Accomplishment:** *Local high school and college students, working under the leadership of a consulting ecologist, have established over 400 long-term monitoring plots on the National Forest land in the Chewaucan watershed of the Fremont-Winema National forest. The purpose of the monitoring is to help determine and evaluate the effect of the watershed restoration projects, including prescribed burning, subsoiling, culvert replacement, streambank restoration, forest thinning, and juniper removal.
