Project Purpose: *Reduce fuels, protect watersheds and wildlife habitat*

Total Title II dollars: *\$704,000 over 3 years*

Federal Agency Appropriated Contribution: *\$699,000*


The Contractor for FY02-FY03 was Agony Gulch. They employed 86 workers (36 of them were local) for 1658 days. Most of the change in condition was accomplished with the Slashbuster machines, with some chainsaw thinning of smaller trees prior to mechanical shredding in some units and prescribed burning. A total of 2000 acres were treated with this contract.

In FY04 the project contractor Coria employed 53 workers for 444 days and treated 2500 acres.

In total 4500 acres were treated and 139 people put to work for 2102 total days.
