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Bridger-Teton National Forest Seek Shuttle Service

Jackson, Wyo. – The Bridger-Teton National Forest, Jackson Ranger District, is soliciting bids for the operation and maintenance of a commercial shuttle service to move people, vehicles and equipment between river access sites along the Snake River from Hoback Junction to Alpine, WY. A special use permit is required to do any business on federal land. This prospectus invites applications from anyone interested in operating a shuttle service on USDA Forest Service lands occurring in the Snake River Canyon as managed by the Bridger-Teton National Forest. One permit to provide these services will be awarded. This action was authorized in the river planning process that is outlined in the *August 19, 1996 Final Area Analysis, May 15, 1997 Environmental Assessment* and resulting *October 21, 1997 Decision Notice*.

The prospectus is long and requires many hours of preparation. All proposals must be submitted before close of business 4:30 p.m. on April 30, 2010. The selection panel will meet and make a decision by May 21, 2010. At that time, a special use permit will be awarded to one candidate business.
