FOREST ORDER

National Forest System Roads

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System roads described in this order within the Skykomish Ranger District, Mt.-Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest until July 16, 2010.

Using any type of vehicle on the Forest Development Roads or segments listed. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, County or local officer, or member(s) of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area.

Road 62 from US 2 south to the Snoqualmie Ranger District boundary, Road 6220, and Road 6221.

This closure is necessary to insure the health and safety of the public and the landowner's employees and contractors in the performance of their duties.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
