OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (a) the following acts are prohibited during occupancy and use of the Shoshone National Forest.

- 1.Camping or otherwise occupying a single location for a period exceeding sixteen (16) consecutive days. **36 CFR 261.58(a)**

The term "location" means the occupied area or campsite and the lands within a five mile radius of that occupied area or campsite. After leaving a location, a minimum of seven (7) days must elapse before any person or group, may re-occupy their original location.

- 2.Launching a boat (from a trailer) except at a designated launching ramp, when a boat ramp is provided.
36 CFR 261.58(r)

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1.Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited activity.
- 2.Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
