SHOSHONE NATIONAL FOREST
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) the following act is prohibited on the areas described in this order within the Shoshone National Forest.

1. Occupying a developed recreation site with prohibited camping equipment. **36 CFR 261.58(d)**

Where posted sleeping in the open or in tents and tent trailers is prohibited. Overnight camping is allowed only with hard sided sleeping units such as trailers, campers, and other motor vehicles, constructed of non-pliable materials.

This restriction is necessary for public safety in areas where grizzly bears are active and is designed to minimize the possibility of human/bear encounters.

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
