SPECIAL CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the Shoshone National Forest.

1. It is prohibited for any person to intentionally approach closer than 100 yards to any bear. **36 CFR 261.53(a) 36 CFR 261.53(e)**

These restrictions are being implemented to, minimize encounters between humans and bears, provide for public health and safety, and for the protection of grizzly bears which are listed as a threatened species.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. **Any person with a valid State of Wyoming hunting license which authorizes the taking of a bear.**
