SHOSHONE NATIONAL FOREST
SPECIAL ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads and trails described in this order and as shown in Exhibit A, within the Shoshone National Forest from December 1 to April 30, annually until further notice.

1. Use of motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles, off Forest Roads (FDR) in the Elk Fork Creek drainage from the Washakie Wilderness Boundary downstream to the North Fork Highway, U.S. 14-16-20, [36 CFR 261.56].
2. Use of motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles, on Forest Road #424 from the public corrals in Elk Fork Campground to its terminus upstream, [36 CFR 261.54(a)].
3. Use of motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles, on the Elk Fork Trail #760 from the Elk Fork Campground to the Washakie Wilderness Boundary, [36 CFR 261.55(b)].

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
