SPECIAL ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the areas, roads and trails described in this order, and as shown in Exhibit A, within the Shoshone National Forest during the period between December 16th through April 30th.

(1) Possessing or using a vehicle off Forest Roads.  
[36 CFR 261.56]

(2) Using any motorized vehicle on the Forest Roads or segments listed. [36 CFR 261.54(a)]

(3) Using any motorized vehicle on the Forest Trails or segments listed. [36 CFR 261.55(b)]

Description of roads and trails closed by this order:

BALD RIDGE - All National Forest System lands, roads, and trails generally lying north of Wyoming Highway 296 (Crandall Road) and east of Dead Indian Hill.

WINDY MOUNTAIN - All National Forest System lands, roads and trails in the Windy Mountain Area, including the Russell Creek, Spring Creek, Tepee Gulch, Painter Gulch, and Trail Creek drainages.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
