SHOSHONE NATIONAL FOREST
SPECIAL ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area and roads described in this order within the Shoshone National Forest until further notice.

1. Using any motorized vehicle on Forest Roads 101 (Sunlight), 108 (Sulphur Creek), and 101.32 (Galena Creek) above the Spring Creek bridge during the periods between April 1 to July 15 and from October 1 to December 1 annually [36 CFR 261.54(a)].
2. Camping within one half (1/2) mile of Sunlight Creek, from its confluence with Sulphur Creek to the North Absaroka Wilderness boundary, approximately five miles upstream [36 CFR 261.58(e)].

This order is established to provide protection for the grizzly bear which formally has been listed as a threatened species.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
