OCCUPANCY AND USE
(Camping)

SIUSLAW NATIONAL FOREST
HEBO RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.5 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Siuslaw National Forest, Hebo Ranger District beginning August 1, 2008 and continuing until rescinded.

- 1) **Camping** is prohibited on the area described in this order unless possessing and using a portable toilet. Portable toilets are defined as a containerized, reusable, commercially available, biodegradable system that is landfill disposable; or a toilet within a camper, trailer, or motor home.


§36 CFR 261.58(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act of omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


