US Forest Service Reopens Grays Peak Trail near Big Bear

SAN BERNARDINO, Calif., July 25, 2008— The San Bernardino National Forest has reopened the popular Grays Peak Trail in the Big Bear Valley. The Grays Peak Trail was damaged during the wildfires last fall and was closed to the public due to safety concerns.

“Grays Peak is one of our more popular hiking and mountain bike trails in Big Bear,” said Mountaintop Recreation Officer Paul Bennett. “Trail Crews ultimately removed over 300 hazard trees, along the trail.”

Forest visitors will need to display a Forest Adventure Pass on their parked vehicle at the Grays Peak Trailhead. Stop by the Big Bear Discovery Center on Highway 38 in Fawnskin for the latest information on trails and other recreational opportunities in the Big Bear Valley.
