**Location:** 23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50 then 19 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3) then 1 mile west on Forest Road 12N78, then 0.5 miles south on Forest Road 12N33. (See map on backside).



### Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between Memorial Day Weekend and early September. These dates may vary.
- ◆ The campground is at about 4,900' elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 1 vehicle and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Maximum stay limit for camping is 14 days per district annually.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.
- ◆ RV filling from piped water sources in campgrounds and day use areas is NOT permitted.






**Location Map**
