



Wench Creek Campground

Eldorado National Forest Pacific Ranger District

Location

23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50 and 15 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3) on the east side of Union Valley Reservoir.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming and fishing,
- ⇒ Water-skiing
- ⇒ Union Valley Bike trail
- ⇒ Bassi Falls hiking trail
- ⇒ Picnic/beach Area at Fashoda Tent campground
- ⇒ Boatramp/loading docks near Sunset & Yellowjacket campgrounds

Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 1 vehicle and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
 - ◇ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.



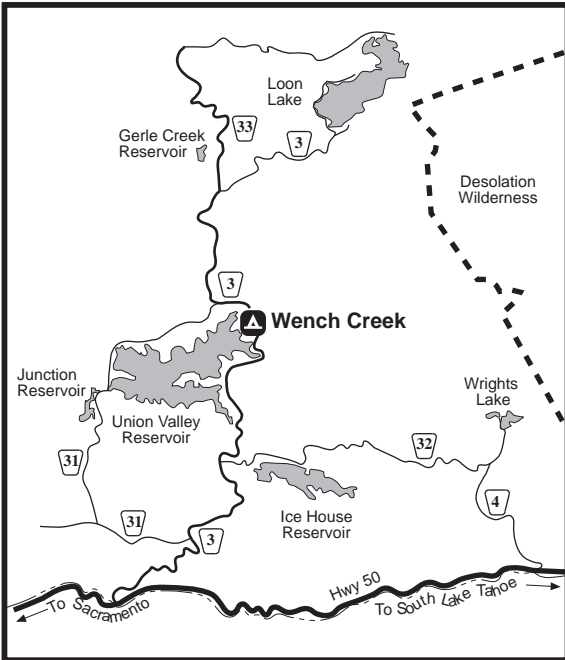
- ◆ RV filling from piped water sources in campgrounds and day use areas is NOT permitted.

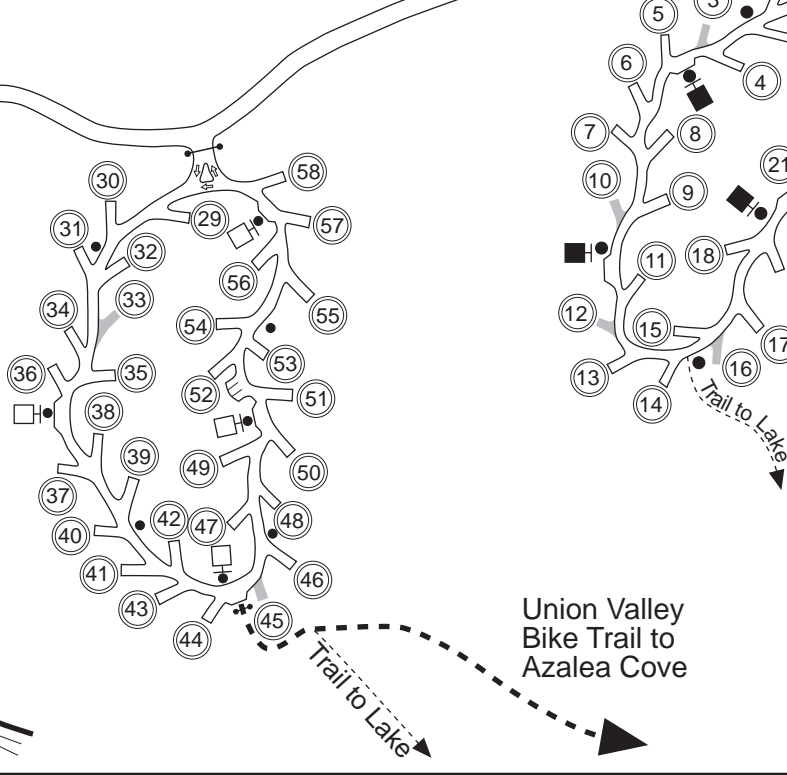
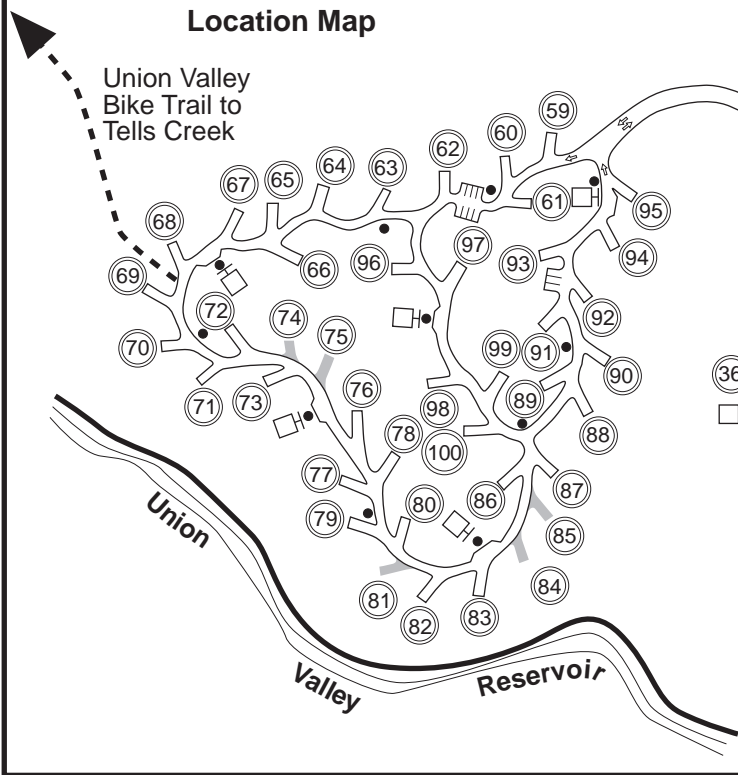






Forest Service
