- ◆ Boating at Gerle Creek Reservoir (no motors allowed)


### Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is at 5,200' elevation.
- ◆ The campground is generally open between mid-June and early November. These dates may vary.
- ◆ Bring water with you.
- ◆ Please use the grill or fire ring provided.
- ◆ Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Keep the gate closed or visitors may wander in. Gate combination will be issued when reservations are finalized.
- ◆ Riding OHV's in the campground is not allowed.
- ◆ Maximum stay limit for camping is 14 days per district annually.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.




