



Northshore Campground

Eldorado National Forest Pacific Ranger District

Location

23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50 and 31 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3), take the Loon Lake fork.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming and Fishing
- ⇒ Boat Ramp at Loon Lake Campground
- ⇒ Picnic Area (5 sites) at the Loon Lake Boat Ramp
- ⇒ Rubicon OHV Trail (summer)
- ⇒ Hiking and horseback riding in Desolation Wilderness (permits required for both day use and overnight use. Overnight permits are available www.recreation.gov or the Pacific Ranger Station on Highway 50, 4 miles east of Pollock Pines). Day use permits area available at the Loon Lake trailhead in the summer and Pacific Ranger Station year-round.
- ⇒ Loon Lake Chalet rental cabin, reservations required.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 2 vehicle and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for extra vehicles if the parking spur will accommodate it.
 - ◇ Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Check ahead. Campfires may not be allowed during fire restrictions.

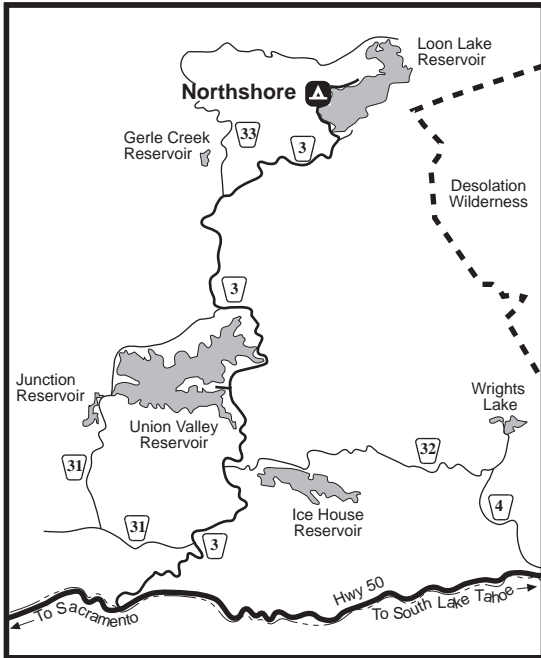

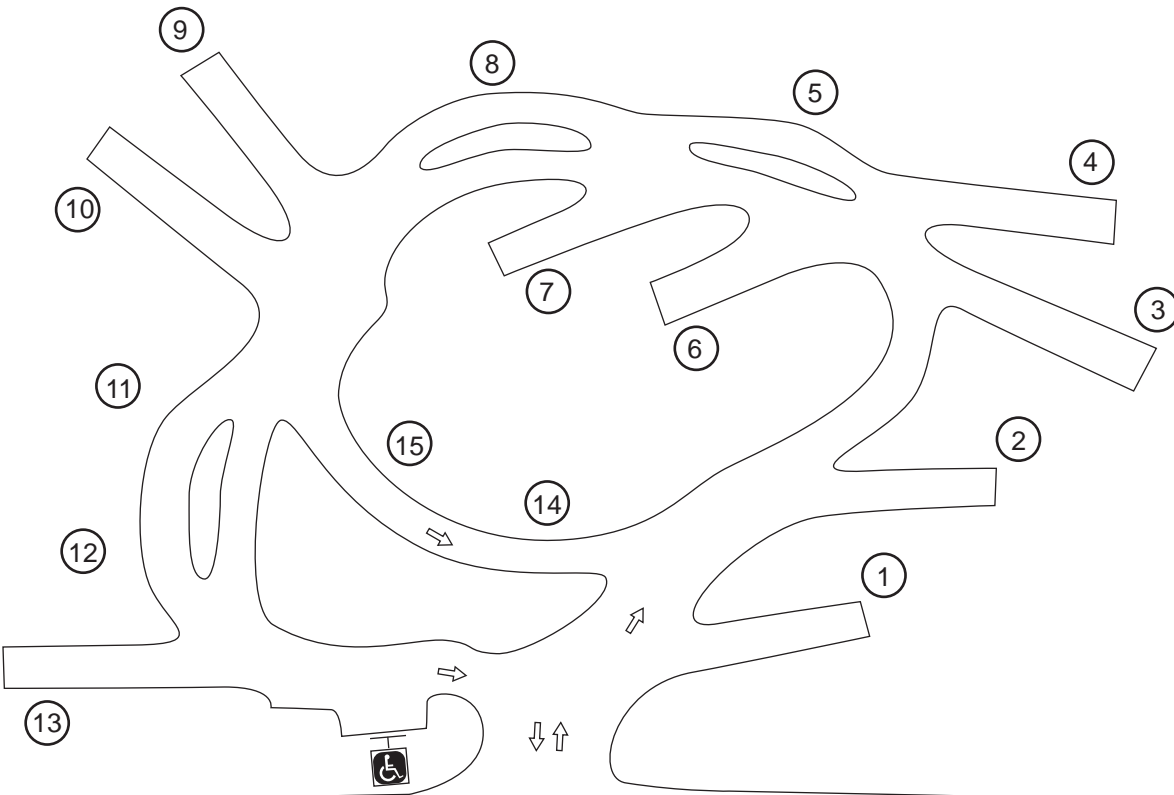
Location Map
