Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Fishing
- ⇒ Picnic Area at Stumpy Meadows Boat Ramp
- ⇒ Boat Ramp/Boarding Dock at Stumpy Meadows Reservoir (no water-skiing is allowed, 5 m.p.h. speed limit).

Things You Should Know

- ◆ CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ 5 parking spurs and a parking area for 10 vehicles.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Use only local firewood to reduce the introduction of invasive insects and diseases.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.



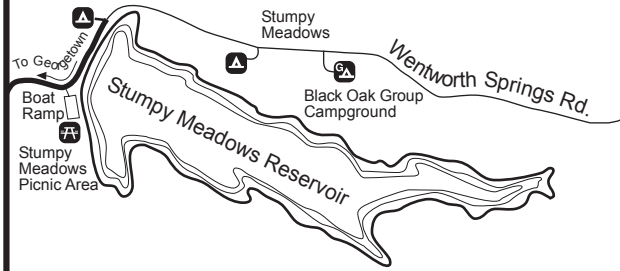

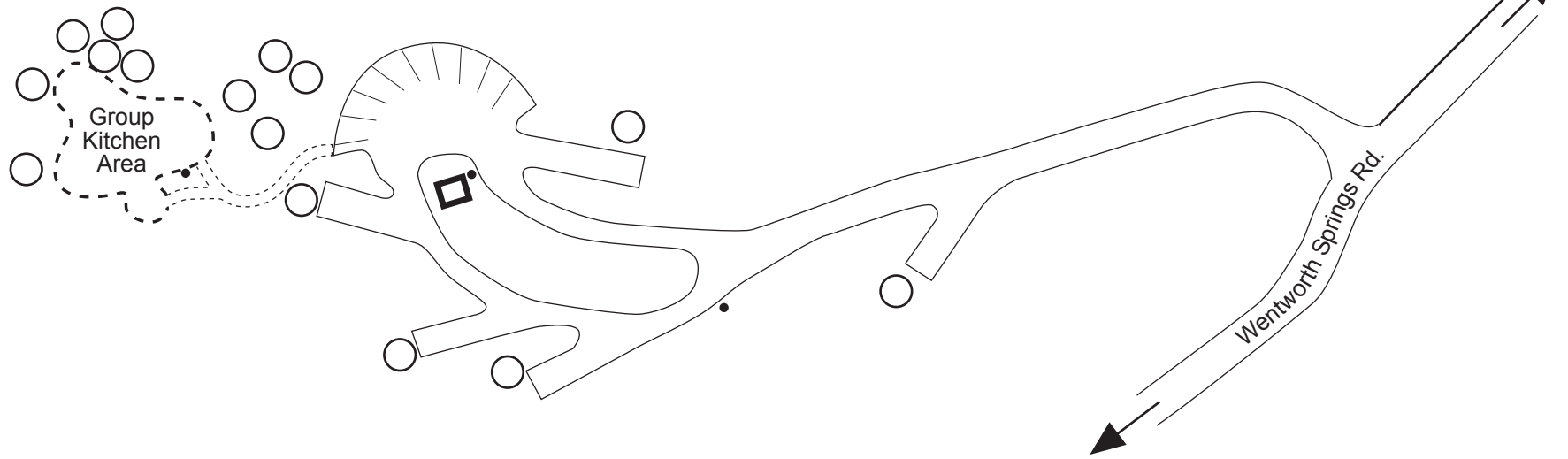
