### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ In units 1, 3, & 4, all vehicles must be kept in the unit's respective parking areas. No trailers are allowed because of the difficulty of getting trailers in and out of these areas.
- ◆ Other fees: RV Dump = \$10.00, Pet = \$1.00
- ◆ Due to the King Fire in 2014, almost all of the trees around units 3 and 4 are gone. There is little shade.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.




