



# Woods Lake Campground

## Eldorado National Forest Amador Ranger District

### Location

63.5 miles east of Jackson on Highway 88 and 2 miles south of the highway near Carson Pass.

### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming
- ⇒ Fishing
- ⇒ Picnicking (8 wheelchair accessible sites)
- ⇒ Boating (No motors allowed at Woods Lake).
- ⇒ Hiking access to Mokelumne Wilderness (permit required for overnight use year-round). Permits available at Carson Pass Information Station (summer only) and the Amador Ranger Station. Fee parking available at Woods Lake trailhead, 1/2 mile before campground.
- ⇒ Caples Lake Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, laundry, fishing licenses, phone, cabin rentals.

### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored in bear boxes.
- ◆ Campground host on site. Please check with the host or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 2 vehicle and 6 people per site and Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
- ◆ Trailers are not recommended because of difficulty of getting trailers in and out of area.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood.

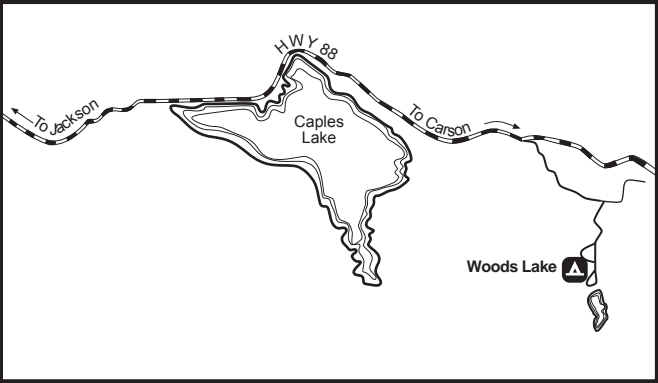
