



# Sugar Pine Point Campground

## Eldorado National Forest

### Amador Ranger District

#### Location

40 miles east of Jackson, 2.5 miles south of Highway 88 via the Bear River Road, and 3 miles east on Forest Road 8N20.

#### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming, Picnicking, Fishing
- ⇒ Bear River Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, fishing licenses, dump station, showers.
- ⇒ Emergency phone at Bear River Resort and Pardoes Point.
- ⇒ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license "green or red sticker" are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes.

#### Things You Should Know

- ◆ CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the lake is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Campground Host on site. Please check with the host or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.

For People with Disabilities**

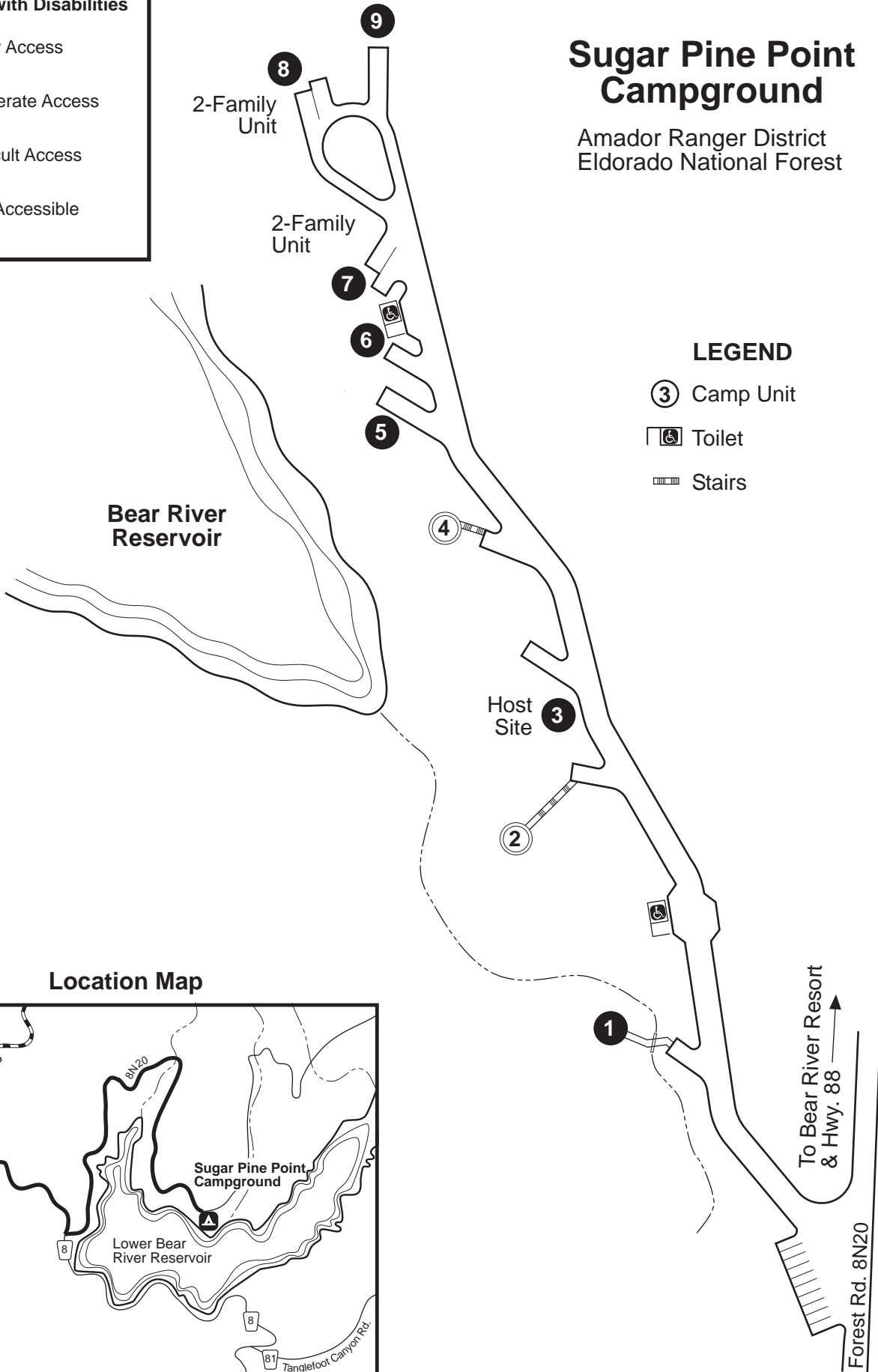
