- ◆ Interagency Senior and Access passes are accepted for single family units.
- ◆ Some sites are available through reservation. All other sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ◆ Swimming , Fishing, Picnicking.
- ◆ Bear River Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, fishing licenses, dump station, and showers.
- ◆ Emergency phone at Bear River Resort and Pardoes Point.

- ◆ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license “green or red sticker” are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ The campground is generally open between May 15th and Oct. 15th. These dates are affected by snowfall.
- ◆ The campground is at about 5,900’ elevation.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Triple units are 6 vehicles and 18 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Campground Host on site. Please check with the host or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Please keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Please use the stove or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil.
- ◆ Maximum stay limit for camping is 14 days per district annually.
- ◆ Check out time is 1:00 p.m.

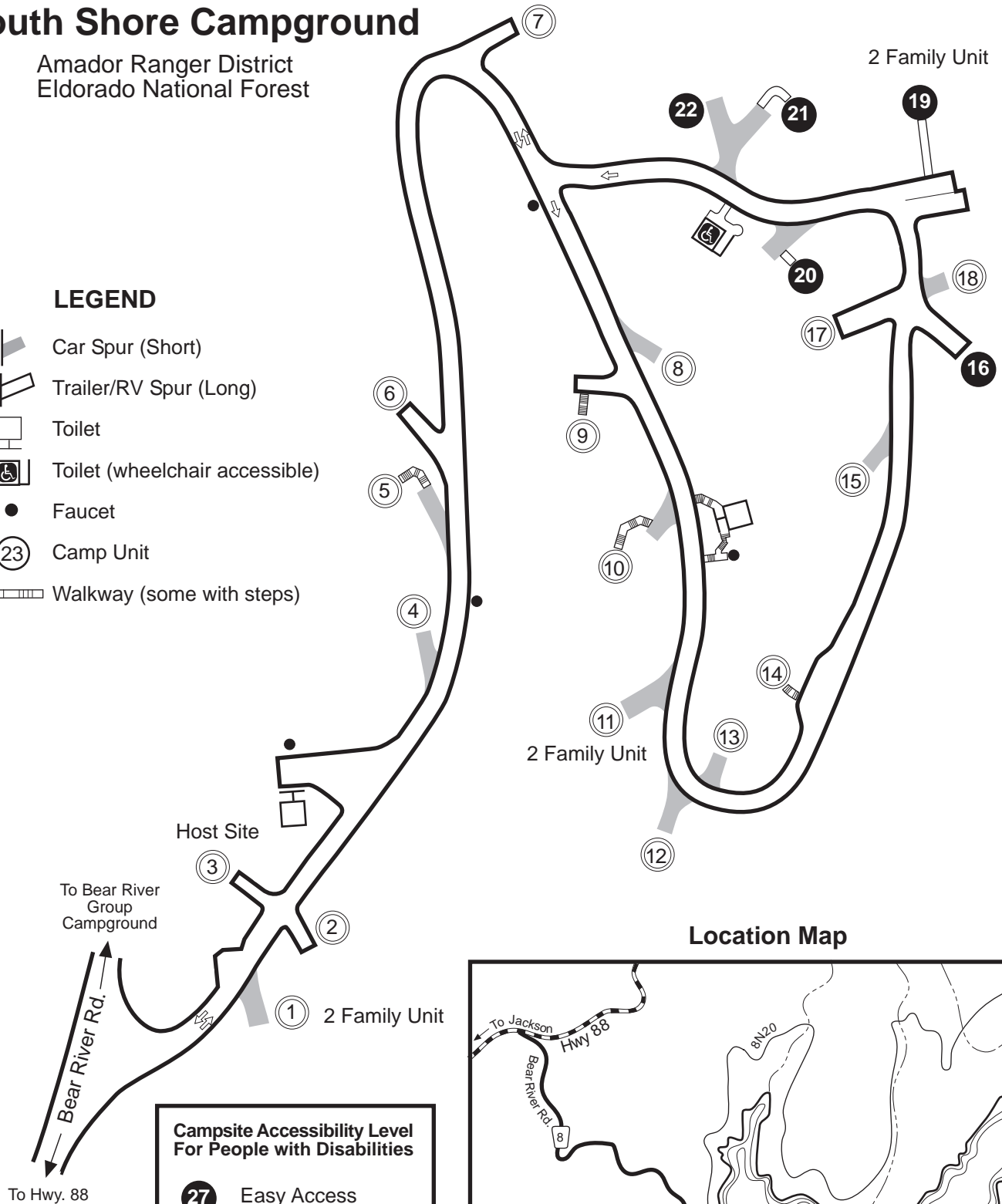

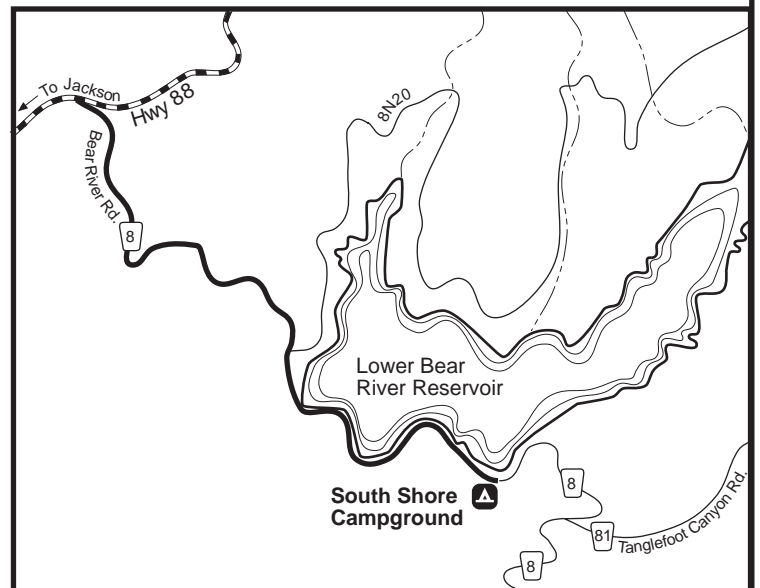
