26 miles east of Jackson, 0.8 miles northwest on Omo Ranch Road and 5.9 miles north on North/South Road.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming, Fishing, Public phone (Calling card only).
- ⇒ Picnic Area (8 sites) near the campground on the river
- ⇒ Wheelchair accessible trail and fishing piers.
- ⇒ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license “green or red sticker” are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes in the Gold Note and Elkins Flat trail areas.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Camp Host on site. Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Single units are limited to a maximum of 2 vehicles and 6 people. Double units are 4 vehicles and 12 people. Triple units are 6 vehicles and 18 people. Additional fee required for extra vehicles.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
