32 miles east of Jackson on Highway 88, 8 miles north on Forest Road 63 (Cat Creek Road).

Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ The Middle Fork Annex which is the former dispersed campsites about 400 feet downstream from the official Middle Fork Campground is also included as a fee site operated by Sierra Recreation Management. Individuals using those Annex sites will have to walk or drive into the main Middle Fork Campground to use the toilets. There are tables, fire rings, and garbage cans at the Annex.
- ◆ Restroom cleaning is provided mid-May to mid-October. Garbage service during summer season.
- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the river is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood.
- ◆ Check ahead. Campfires may not be allowed during fire restrictions.

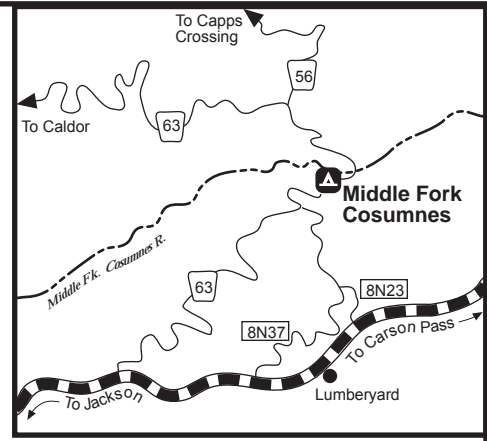
