



Bear River Group Campground

Eldorado National Forest Amador Ranger District

Location

40 miles east of Jackson on Highway 88 then go south 2 1/2 miles on Bear River Road. At the "Y" intersection go west (right) across the dam. Travel 2 miles staying to the left.

Reservation Information

- ◆ CALL 1-877-444-6777 four days to 12 months in advance of your stay.
- ◆ Call Sierra Recreation Managers (SRM) for site availability outside of the reservation window at (209) 295-4512.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming, Fishing, Picnicking.
- ⇒ Bear River Resort: restaurant, store, boat launch, boat rentals, fishing licenses, dump station, showers.
- ⇒ Emergency phone at Bear River Resort and Pardoes Point campground.
- ⇒ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license "green or red sticker" are not legal on campground roads. These vehicles must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored in bear boxes.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.



◆ Park all vehicles in the parking lot. Vehicles may be driven to the camping area to load and unload only. For persons with special needs, a vehicle may be left at the campsite, with the host's approval.

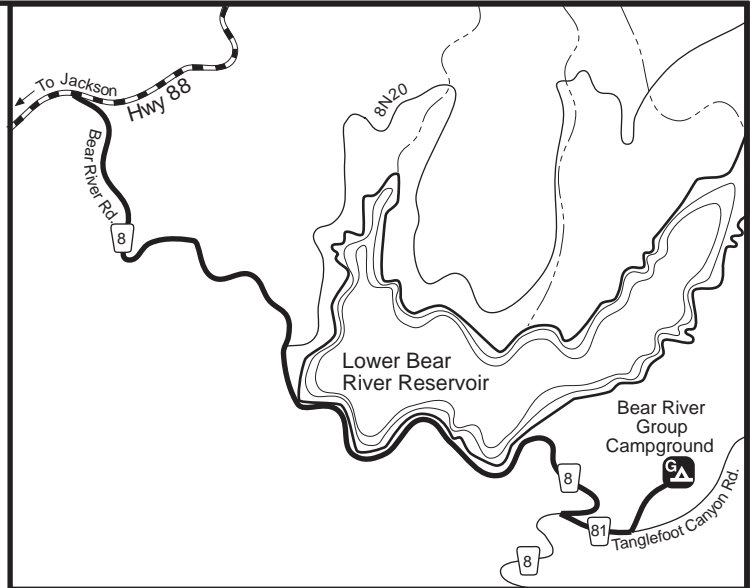

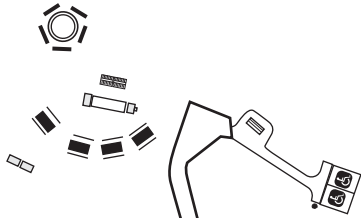

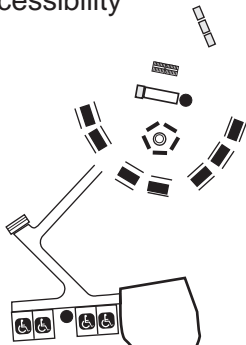


Location Map

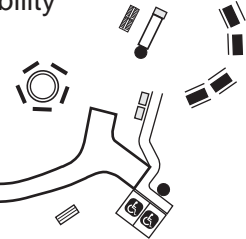
