**Overview:** TerraGo Technologies provides a service allowing for Geospatially enhanced Acrobat Reader files. The user will be able to identify Road Segments to locate such information as Mode of Travel, Road Number, and Seasonally Open Dates. The technically savvy user will be able to incorporate The user can utilize these tools with the simple installation of a plug-in.

Download and install or upgrade to the most recent version of Adobe Acrobat Reader. (<http://www.adobe.com/>)



### VIEWING DATA IN ACROBAT.

Open up the Santa Fe Travel Map of interest (the file should have a *.pdf* extension at the end). Your product should look something like the following:




## ZOOMING AND PANNING AROUND THE MAP

Basic Zooming can be done by hitting the Zoom Tools at the top of Acrobat Reader..



Advanced Zooming and Panning are available through Tools>Select and Zoom



## TURNING LAYERS ON AND OFF

If the Layers are not visible, click on the Layers Button on the left-hand side of the screen.



You should now have the option to turn layers on and off by clicking the eye symbol.




## FIND A FEATURE BY ITS NAME

Type the feature name (such as Seven Springs) into the Find Box at the top of the screen. Click the drop-down arrow to find the feature.



## USE THE OBJECT DATA TOOL TO IDENTIFY ATTRIBUTES OF A ROAD



Click the .

*If the Object Data tool is not visible, navigate to the View menu > Toolbars > Object Data option.*

Zoom in on a Road Segment. Move the mouse over the segment until the crosshairs appear, then click on it.

The attributes should appear on the left.
