**Grazing Restriction:**

No current grazing restrictions apply to this allotment.

**Allowable Use:**

The maximum allowable utilization on forage is 35%. This allowable use is based on a four-pasture deferred rotation. Range and watershed resources are estimated to be in Fair stable or better condition.

**Utilization Monitoring of Key Areas:**

Utilization monitoring will be conducted on key areas. District personnel will monitor key areas at a mid point and/or two weeks before or after livestock are moved off the Pasture. The percentage of grazing utilization will be determined at the time of monitoring. Please note the following dates that are scheduled for monitoring on the Jewett Gap Allotment. You are encouraged to participate in monitoring utilization levels.

**Actual Use:**

Due to Personal Convenience non-use no actual use has been recorded for the 2004, 2005, and 2006 grazing seasons.

**Forage Growth and Water Availability:**

If forage growth and water availability are not adequate during all or portions of the 2007 grazing season, total or partial removal of livestock from the allotment may be necessary. Part 2, clause 8(c) of the grazing permit provides this option.

**Range developments:**

All assigned range developments identified in the Term Grazing Permit must be maintained to a functional status.
