

PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED ACTION

Grove Creek Spring Drainage
USDA Forest Service – Uinta National Forest
Utah County, Utah

Pleasant Grove Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, has received a request from Pleasant Grove City and Cornerstone Group, Inc., to provide an outlet to control and manage water being held in a small pond (about .10 acre) immediately north of Grove Creek Trailhead. Pleasant Grove City and Cornerstone Group have presented a design for a drainage channel and culvert to direct the pond water into the Grove Creek Debris Basin in the south side of the road below the trailhead. Pleasant Grove City would assume responsibility for maintenance of the drainage structures located on National Forest System lands. The project area is located near the mouth of Grove Creek Canyon, within Section 22, T 5 S., R 2, E., Salt Lake Base Meridian.
