The Spanish Fork Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest is conducting an environmental analysis for a proposal to continue current livestock management on the the Sabie Mountain Allotment which have demonstrated to be meeting or satisfactorily moving toward desired conditions.

The Sabie Mountain Allotment is located in the Vernon Management Area, near Lofgreen Utah, Tooele County in T9S, R4W, Sections 7, 8, 17-20, 27-34 and T10S R4W Sections 5-8 and 17-18.

Currant Management: The Sabie Mountain Allotment is permitted to graze 288 cow/calf pairs from 05/06 to 07/31 under a term grazing permit and 25 cow/calf pairs during the same period under a private land term grazing permit. It is managed with a rest-rotation grazing system. The allotment is managed to meet the Uinta National Forest 2003 Land and Resource Management Plan.

The public is invited to provide comment on this proposal. Send comments to the Responsible Official, Doug Jones, District Ranger, Spanish Fork Ranger District, 44 West 400 North, Spanish Fork, Utah 84660. Oral or written comments may also be submitted at Spanish Fork Ranger District during normal business hours from 8:00 to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, excluding federal holidays. Comments should be received September 4, 2007, to ensure full consideration. Based on preliminary analysis, this project may be categorically excluded from analysis and documentation in an environmental assessment or environmental impact statement.
