The Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, has completed environmental analyses of the Juab County Gravel Pit Permit Reissuance. Responsible Official, Forest Supervisor, Brian Ferebee, approved the Decision Memo for this project on September 21, 2007. The project would authorize Juab County to continue to use the gravel pit for gravel needs in the County.
