Dear Friends,

This letter is to inform you of the decision for the Hells Hollow Prescribed Burn Project. The project is located about 10 miles east of Logan, Utah. A scoping letter on the proposed project was distributed in October 2005. The purpose of the project is to begin to restore declining aspen and decadent sagebrush communities in the analysis area. The project involves approximately 6,000 acres within 6 burn units and implements a series of prescribed burns in aspen, aspen/conifer, and sagebrush communities. The Decision Memo is enclosed and is also available on the Forest website at <http://www.fs.fed.us/r4/wcnf/projects/>.

Pursuant to Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck, No. CIV F-03-6386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is subject to appeal pursuant to Forest Service regulations at 36 CFR 215. Appeals must meet the content requirements of 36 CFR 215.14. Only individuals or organizations who submitted comments or otherwise expressed interest in the project during the comment period may appeal. Appeals must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Deciding Officer within 45 days of the publication of this notice in the Logan Herald Journal. This date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Timeframe information from other sources should not be relied on. Incorporation of documents by reference is not allowed. The Appeal Deciding Officer is Faye L. Krueger, Forest Supervisor. Emailed appeals must be submitted in rich text (rtf), Word (doc) or portable document format (pdf) and must include the project name in the subject line. Appeals may also be hand delivered to the above address, during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
