## RECREATION RESERVATIONS

The National Recreation Reservation Service takes reservations for most campgrounds up to 120 days in advance at **1-877-444-6777** or on the Internet at **[www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov)**. These sites can be reserved no less than 5 days in advance. Reservations are for summer season only. This season reservable dates start June 14, 2024.

**The Lily Lake dump and water station is **Open**. The water is **NOT** potable. ( Not safe to Drink)**

### **Utah Off-highway Vehicle (OHV) Law**

Beginning Jan. 1, 2023, Utah will require all OHV operators to complete the Utah Off-Highway Vehicle Education Course. Operators under the age of 18 shall possess a youth OHV education certificate in order to operate an OHV on public land, road or trail. Operators 18 years of age or older may operate an OHV if they possess an approved adult OHV education certificate. The test will be available beginning January 1, 2023.

### **Boating, Kayak, Paddleboards, etc.**

All boaters — whether you are a Utah resident or nonresident — must take the annual Utah mussel-aware boater course and have proof of course completion in your launch vehicle. This includes users of all kinds of watercraft, including motorized boats and human-powered kayaks, canoes, paddleboards, etc. To learn more, visit [stdofthesea.utah.gov](http://stdofthesea.utah.gov).

Camping in dispersed areas on the Forest is allowed for fourteen (14) days in any thirty (30) day consecutive period. Campers must move off Forest after reaching the 14-day limit. The stay limit also applies to all camping equipment (tents, chairs, ATVs, ATV trailers, etc.), even if used by a different person or group. Camping equipment must be removed by the end of the fourteen (14) day stay limit or the equipment may be impounded. Stay limits are implemented to reduce impacts to vegetation and wildlife habitat, as well as provide access to popular campsite areas for other visitors.
