REQUEST FOR COMMENTS**

The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest, in coordination with the Utah Reclamation, Mitigation, and Conservation Central Commission, is proposing to drill 9-15 temporary monitoring wells. The purpose of the proposed action would be to monitor groundwater levels in Strawberry Valley to determine groundwater-surface water interaction and viability of restoring stream flow to the existing channel. The project would be located approximately two miles north of the Highway 40 crossing of Strawberry River (Township 2 South, Range 12 West, Sections 9 and 15).

The Forest service is seeking public comment on the proposed action.
