The Heber-Kamas Ranger District of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest is analyzing approximately 1500 acres in an area southeast of Strawberry Reservoir for sagebrush treatments. The project is located in T3S, R7W, S 23,24,25,26, and 36; and T4S, R7W, S1, 11, and 12, Wasatch County, Utah. The proposed project would treat sagebrush on approximately 60-75% of the project area using a Dixie harrow or brushhog to reduce sagebrush canopy and improve sage-grouse brood-rearing habitat.

The Forest Service is seeking public comment on the proposed action.
