FOOD AND TRASH STORAGE RULES

Every camper and visitor **MUST** follow the rules below.
Violators will be warned and may be asked to leave.

ALWAYS store food, toiletries, coolers, grills, and all other scented items in storage lockers provided. If storage lockers are not provided store out of sight in your vehicle.

ALWAYS close storage lockers and vehicles when not in use.

ALWAYS place trash in bear-resistant dumpsters, storage locker or out of sight in your vehicle.

NEVER leave scented items unattended or in your tent or car.

NEVER leave trash at your campsite.

NEVER feed wildlife.

IF A BEAR ENTERS THE CAMPGROUND

Do not approach, confront, encircle or chase the bear - back away slowly.
Keep you, your children, and your pets at a distance
Contact the campground host.
