**Road Prohibitions and Trail Closure within Cameron Peak Fire Area**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) roads and trails in the Canyon Lakes Ranger District, Roosevelt National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “Described Roads and Trails”):

1. Using any motor vehicle on the Described Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a).
2. Being on the Described Trail. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with valid recreation residence permits who have coordinated with the permit administrator for exemption from this Order.
2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
3. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.
4. Authorized Federal, State, local, contractor, and subcontractor personnel implementing post-fire recovery projects and associated activities on the Described Roads and Trails.

## **DESCRIBED ROADS AND TRAILS**

Restricted Roads: Using any motor vehicle on roads shown as “Closed to motorized use” on Exhibit A and described on Exhibit B.

Restricted Trails: The NFS Trails as shown on Exhibit A and described on Exhibit B.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety on roads and trails affected by the 2020 Cameron Peak Fire and post-fire flooding.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order shall be in effect from December 1, 2022, at 12:01 a.m. through June 15, 2023, at 11:59 p.m., unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Roads and Trails is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/arp/alerts-notice>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders (ARP-CLRD-2022-09) prohibiting the same or similar acts on the same Described Roads and Trail.
