



Forest Order No. STF-16-2023-04 Stanislaus National Forest Road Closures

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Stanislaus National Forest. This Order is effective from April 19, 2023, through December 31, 2023.

Being on the following National Forest System Roads, as illustrated on Exhibit A:

- Forest Road No. 1N10 (Lumsden Road), from its intersection with Ferretti Road, continuing east to its intersection with Forest Road No. 1N10C.
- 2. Forest Road No. 1N07 (Cherry Lake Road), from its intersection with Forest Road No. 1S02, continuing north to its intersection with Forest Road No. 3N01.
- 3. Forest Road No. 1S02 (Mather Road), from its intersection with Forest Road No. 1S83, continuing east to its intersection with Forest Road No. 1S26.

36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
