Area & Road Closure

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands and road in Edna Creek Campground on the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “Described Area and Described Road”):

1. Going into or being upon the Described Area. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)
2. Being on the Described Road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation of Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e)(1) or (2).

DESCRIBED AREA AND ROAD:

The Described Area is all NFS lands within the Edna Creek Campground, which is in the northwest corner of Section 16, Township 7N, Range 7 East, Boise Meridian, Idaho City Ranger district, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho.

The Described Road **NFS Road #384A** (also known as the Edna Campground Road) beginning at its junction with NFS Road 384 in Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 7 East Boise Meridian, running entire length of road, and ending at the point of beginning.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety during construction at Edna Creek Campground.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order shall be in effect from May 18, 2023, at 12:01 AM through December 31, 2023, at 12:00 PM, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Area and Road is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/boise/alerts-notice>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts on the same Described Area or on the same Described Road.
