

FOREST ORDER NO. 05-01-23-05  
BOBCAT FIRE AREA, ROAD, AND TRAIL CLOSURE  
ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST & SAN GABRIEL MOUNTAINS NATIONAL MONUMENT

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Angeles National Forest and San Gabriel Mountains National Monument. This Order is effective from June 1, 2023, through May 31, 2024.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Bobcat Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e).
2. Being on the following National Forest System Roads within the Bobcat Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B:
  - a. Forest Road No. 2N24,
  - b. Forest Road No. 2N31, or
  - c. Forest Road No. 2N41.

36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Bobcat Fire Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A, shown on Exhibit B, and listed in Exhibit C. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of land, to the extent necessary to access their land.
4. Permanent residents, to the extent necessary to access their permanent residences.
5. Employees, agents, and customers (with written reservation confirmation) of Adams Pack Station, for events at the Pack Station's permitted facility only.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

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EXHIBIT A

The boundary of the Angeles National Forest Bobcat Closure Area begins at the intersection of the Angeles National Forest congressional boundary and Forest Trail No. 11W22 (Mt. Wilson Trail in Little Santa Anita Canyon) in section 9 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian (SBBM); then continues north along the eastern edge of the trail to the western edge of Section 9 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, SBBM; then continues north along the section line to the southern edge of Forest Road No. 2N24 in Section 20 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, SBBM; then continues east along the southern edge of Forest Road No. 2N24 to the intersection of Forest Road No. 2N31 in Section 36 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, SBBM; then continues south along the eastern edge of Forest Road No. 2N31 to Clamshell Peak in Section 1 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, SBBM; then continues south along the section line to the Angeles National Forest congressional boundary in Section 13 of Township 1 North, Range 11 West, SBBM; then continues west along the congressional boundary back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit B.
