Road and Trail Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) roads and trails in the Idaho Ranger District, Boise National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Described Roads and Trails"):

1. Being on the Described Roads and Trails. 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.54(e), 261.55(a)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Contractors while performing work pursuant to the contract for the Bear Run Timber Sale.

DESCRIBED ROADS AND TRAILS

The portion of NFS Road (NFSR) #314 beginning at the NFS lands in Section 25, Township 6 North, Range 6 East, Boise Meridian and ending at NFSR #314 mile post 4.6 in Section 7, Township 6 North, Range 6 East, Boise Meridian.

The entirety of NFSR #314C, 314C1, 314C2, 314C3, 314B, 314D and 314D1, which are in Sections 13, 18, 19, and 30, Township 6 North, Range 6 East, and Sections 13, 24 and 25, Township 6 North, Range 5 East, Boise Meridian.

The entirety of NFS Trails #670, 671, 672, 673, 674, 675 and 676, which are in Sections 13, 24, and 52, Township 6 North, Range 5 East, and Sections 18, 19, and 30, Township 6 North, Range 6 East, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety during timber operations.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from December 15, 2023, at 8:00 am through March 1, 2024, at 12:01 am, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Roads and Trails is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/boise/alerts-notices>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts in the same Described Roads and Trails.
