Open for the 2024 Season:

North Rd. FS 21S50.

Summit, Clicks Creek and Lewis Camp Trailheads.

A separate wilderness permit is required for each trip.

A group of less than 15 persons camping and traveling together only needs one permit.

This permit will be valid for travel into adjacent Forest Service and National Park Service wilderness areas, as specified on your itinerary.

If starting your trip from a Park Service trailhead, you must obtain a permit from the National Park Service.

**Plan accordingly** Some areas have visitor and trailhead quotas, reservation requirements, and charge a fee for the issuance of visitor passes. Collecting this information about where visitors travel helps track visitor use patterns to protect the wilderness from visitor impacts and overuse.

**CAMPFIRES:** In areas where campfires are allowed, you will need a valid Campfire Permit which can be obtained for free online:

Campfire and stove use may be restricted. It is your responsibility to check on the current regulations at any Forest Service office or National Park office.
