I am pleased to inform you of the availability of the second Biennial Monitoring Evaluation Report (BMER) for the 2018 revised Coconino National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan (Forest Plan). This report summarizes the findings of the monitoring required by the Forest Plan monitoring strategy, with data collected in fiscal years 2021 and 2022.

I have evaluated the results presented in this report and endorse them. If needed, this biennial monitoring report would recommend changes to the Forest Plan's management direction or monitoring strategy. There are, however, recommendations for additional management and monitoring activities to support moving forest resources toward desired conditions. I have directed staff to incorporate these recommendations into their program management.
