**Cave Springs Campground Temporary Closure**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) in the Red Rock Ranger District, Coconino National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Described Area"):

1. Going into or being upon the designated areas 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e).
2. Being on the Described Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

**DESCRIBED AREA/ROADS/TRAILS**

The described area as depicted on the map in Exhibit A includes all NFS lands and roads within 500 feet of NFS Road 89D (entrance to Cave Springs Campground, 35° 0' 1.4" N, 111° 44' 14.0" W) with the exception of areas east of the southbound shoulder of State Route 89A. This area includes the Harding Springs Trailhead and all roadside parking along the west side of State Route 89A between 35° 0' 5.6" N, 111° 44' 11.0" W and 34° 59' 37.2" N, 111° 44' 12.6" W and access to Oak Creek within the closure area (between 35° 0' 6.6" N, 111° 44' 17.0" W and 34° 59' 34.9" N, 111° 44' 14.2" W).


## PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to provide for public health and safety due to bank stabilization work on the main Cave Springs Campground access road.

## IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 at 12:00 am through March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 at 11:59 pm unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Road and Described Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/coconino/alerts-notices>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts in/on the same Described Road and Described Area.

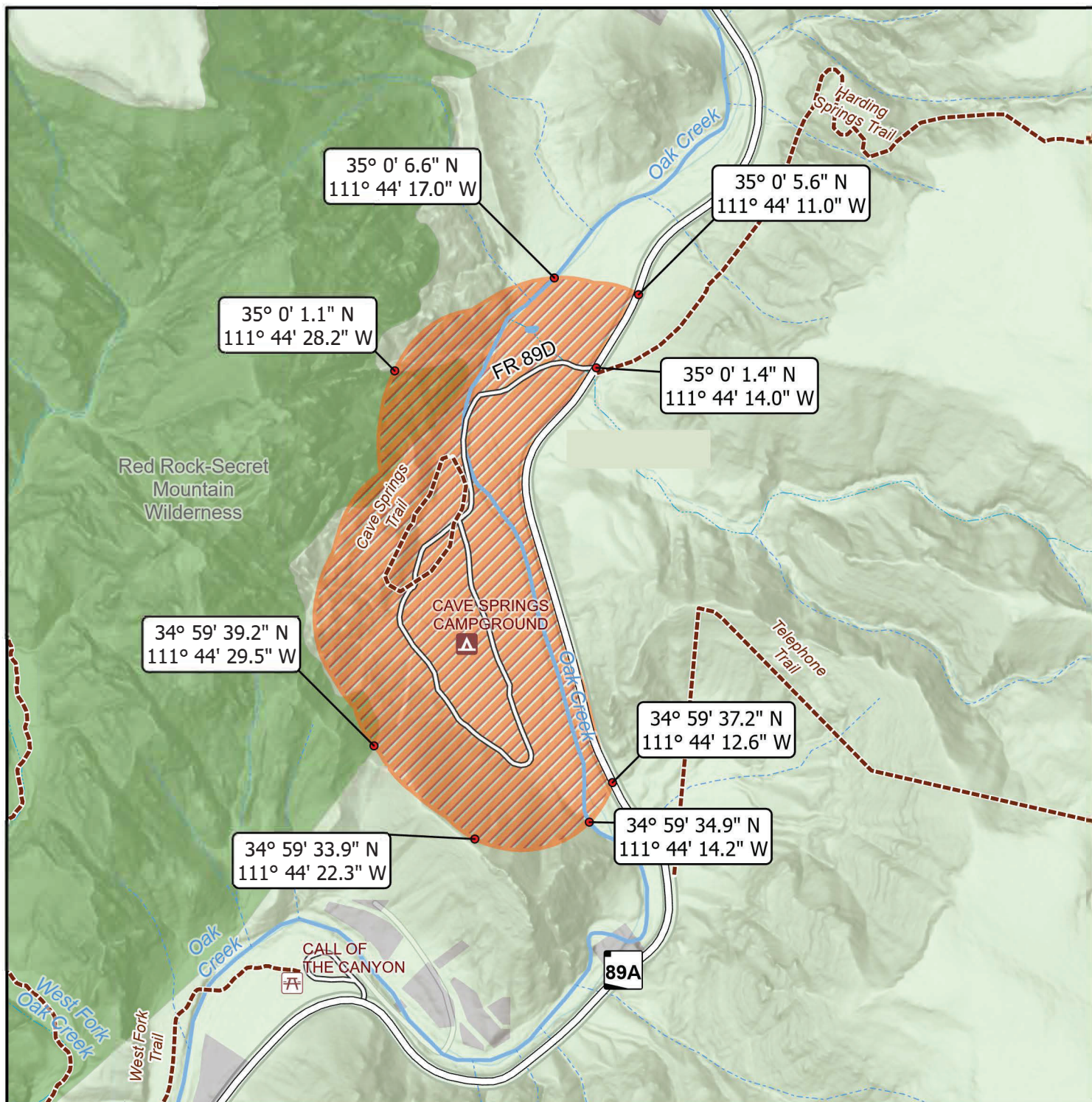
