Occupancy and Use

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.50(a) and 261.53(e), the following is prohibited in the Trout Pond Area off the Lee Ranger District, George Washington and Jefferson National Forests.

Note: Rockcliff Lake, Rockcliff Trail and Fisherman Trail are not included in the closure area.

Going into or being upon the Construction Zone depicted on the attached map(s). The Construction Zone includes, but is not limited to, the Administrative Area, Trailer Dump Station, Campground, Picnic Area, Picnic Shelter and the Trail and area around the pond.

THE PROHIBITIONS OF THIS ORDER WILL BE IN EFFECT SEPTEMBER 14, 2015, AND WILL REMAIN EFFECTIVE UNTIL WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the prohibitions contained in this order:

Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Roanoke, Virginia this 6th day of October, 2015.


