***ROAD CLOSURE***  
**Tepee Springs Fire – Version #7**  
*(For Public Safety)*

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b) the following act is prohibited on the lands described in this order, all within the administrative boundaries of the New Meadows Ranger District, Payette National Forest. This Order will be in effect beginning **September 24, 2015 at 2:00 P.M.** and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Being on the road (as described in this order). **36 CFR 261.54(e)**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**ROAD DESCRIPTION:**

**NFS Road #104 (Lake Creek Road)** is closed to all uses beginning at the intersection of Forest Road #103 (Salmon River Road) and continuing Southerly to the roads terminus, all within Township 24 North, Range 2 East, Sections 21, 28 and 33.

The above described road is located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the New Meadows Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Idaho County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

**PURPOSE:**

The road, as described above, has ongoing wildfire activity (Tepee Springs Fire). The road is closed to all public access for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect beginning **September 24, 2015 at 2:00 P.M.** and shall remain in effect until further her notice.
2. A map identifying the road closure is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order on the roads covered by this order.
