

NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE

Plumas National Forest

The South Alma Salvage is a Scaled Sale, located approximately one mile south of Lake Almanor, CA, and southwest of the unincorporated town of Canyon Dam, CA. The legal description is: T27N, R8E, Sec. 28, 29, 32, & 33, Mt Diablo Base & Meridian. This sale is comprised of three salvage units, totaling 22.7 acres of timber windthrown by the wind event of February, 2015. The total estimated NET saw log volume to be cut and removed is 45.58 MBF. The estimated volume per species is: ponderosa pine 3.88 MBF (7 trees), sugar pine 14.27 MBF (11 trees), white fir 22.74 MBF (104 trees), Douglas fir 3.06 MBF (9 trees) and incense cedar 1.63 MBF (12 trees). On October 21, 2015, at 11:00 AM local time the Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at the Supervisor's Office, Plumas National Forest, 159 Lawrence Street, QUINCY, CA. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of sawtimber in all salvage units that the bidder may agree to remove. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus, bid form, and other information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and submission of bids from the Plumas National Forest, Mt Hough RD, 39696 Hwy 70, Quincy, CA 95971 or call (530)283-0555.
