EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. # 08-13-08-15-04

National Forest System Multi-Use Trails Closed to all Users

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart B, the following acts are prohibited due to recent flood events for the protection of public health, safety, and natural resources.

- AFFECTED AREA:** Lyndon B. Johnson National Grasslands National Forest System (NFS)
Multi-Use Trails defined and shown on the attached map.
- EFFECTIVE DATES:** July 1, 2015 and until rescinded.
- PROHIBITED ACT:** No person may enter, go into or be upon the NFS trails defined and shown
as closed on the attached map.
36 CFR § 261.53 (e) and § 261.55 (a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- a. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- b. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
