





Civil Rights Impact Statement

Proposed Action

To implement an area closure described in this document, also known as the Grizzly Bear Complex, located on the Walla Walla and Pomeroy Ranger Districts, Umatilla National Forest pursuant to **Pursuant to 16 USC, 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)**

The following persons are exempt from this order pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Duration

Temporary, up to one year of signature date, unless amended or revoked by the Forest Supervisors

Employee/Community Involvement

The following Special Emphasis Program Managers (SEPM) will review and approve this proposed Order:
Umatilla National Forest Civil Rights Officers

Justification

Currently, there are fire suppression and rehabilitation activities occurring in the described area.

As a result of the action being proposed, the following results, along with others, could be experienced:

1. Adequate signing and posting fire personnel at key intersection points, backed by a Forest Order and enforcement, will discourage the public from entering the Grizzly Bear Complex area.

Mitigation

The following are suggested mitigations:

1. Ensure signing is adequate in significant locations.
2. To ensure the Pomeroy and Walla Walla Ranger District office front desk personnel are familiar with this information to educate and inform the public.

Implementation

Announcements are placed in the local papers; the Order is posted at the Ranger Districts, and Supervisor's Office.
